Prospective authors must adhere to the following guidelines: (1) article length is 10 pages minimum and 15 pages maximum, including bibliography and appendices; (2) abstract and its key words are included; (3) the article may be written by three persons maximum and it can also be written in English; and (4) attach a bio mentioning author's current profession, newest photograph, and postal and e-mail addresses.

The article should follow the outline:

Abstract (should be written in English)

Findings and Discussion

References (contains literature cited in the text)
